

AIREADO DUET Shoulder Cowl



Approximate Dimensions: 26” circumference at neck, 42” circumference at hem

Materials:

Aireado Duet: 1 – 100g skein, color 205

White/Beige

Gauge: 14 sts, 20 rows= 4” in st st on US Size 10 (6mm) knitting needle *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 10 (6mm) 24” and 32” circular knitting needle, 10 stitch markers- 9 in one color and 1 in another.

Cowl is worked in the round starting at the hem.

3x2 Ribbing (Multiple of 5 sts)

Rnd 1: *K3, p2; rep from * around.

Rep this rnd for pattern st.

2x1 Ribbing (Multiple of 3 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p1; rep from * around.

Rep this rnd for pattern st.

Begin

Hem

With longer circular needle, very loosely long-tail CO 150 sts- placing a marker after every 15th stitch using the 9 matching markers. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm that is a different color than the rest to notate the beg of the rnd.

Work in 3x2 Ribbing for 2 ½”.

Body

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: *K to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * around—10 sts dec’d. (140 sts on needle)

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: *K to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * around—10 sts dec’d. (130 sts on needle)

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnds 6-20: Knit.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, m= marker, mm= millimeter, p= purl, p2tog= purl two stitches together, p3tog= purl three stitches together, rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, ssk =slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st =stockinette st, WS= wrong side, yo= yarn over

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Work rnds 1-20 once more. (110 sts on needle)

Switch to short circular needle.

Work rnds 1-5 once more. (90 sts on needle)

Remove all m except the beg of rnd m.

Work in 2x1 ribbing for 2". BO all sts on next rnd in ribbing- loosely. Weave in all ends and block.

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
