

AIREADO DUET Textured Hat & Cowl



Size: Hat: 18" x 9" tall; Cowl: 27 x 8"

Materials:

Aireado Duet: Hat and short cowl can be knit together from 1 hank

Shown in color 201 Light Grey/Charcoal Duet

Gauge: 4.5 sts = 1" over st st

Needles:

Hat: 16" circulars size 7 & 8. double pointed needles size US 8; 1 stitch marker.

Cowl: 24" circular size US 7 & 8, 1 stitch marker.

NOTE FOR HAT: If longer length is desired, work rows 9-16 once more before working the final set of rounds 9-12 prior to beginning the decreasing.

Begin Hat:

With smaller circular needles loosely cast on 80 sts. Place stitch marker, and join to work in the round, taking care not to twist.

Rounds 1-8: *(K1, p1); repeat from * around.

Rounds 9-12: Change to size larger circular needles and purl around.

Rounds 13-16: *(K1, p1); repeat from * around.

Repeat Rounds 9-16: 4 more times (that's 5 times total) then work rounds 9-12 once more.

Begin decreasing, changing to double points when needed.

Round 1: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Knit around.

Round 3: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 4: Knit around.

Round 5: *(K4, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 6: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 7: *(K2, k2tog); repeat from * around.

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Round 8: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 9: *(K2tog); repeat from * around.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor to inside.

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.

Begin Cowl:

With larger needles, loosely cast on 120 sts. Place stitch marker, and join to work in the round, taking care not to twist.

Change to smaller needles to work the body of the cowl.

Rounds 1-8: *(K1, p1); repeat from * around.

Rounds 9-12: Change to size larger circular needles and purl around.

Rounds 13-16: *(K1, p1); repeat from * around.

Repeat Rounds 9-16: 4 more times (that's 5 times total) then work rounds 9-12 once more.

Begin working ribbing with smaller needles, working 8 rounds.

Bind off VERY LOOSELY in ribbing, using larger needles.

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.

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
