## FANTASY NATURALE Tulip Washcloth



Finished Size (Approx): 9" square
Materials: $1-100 \mathrm{~g}$ hank of Fantasy Naturale. Shown in color 3611.
Gauge: 18 sts $=4$ " on a US 7 needle over garter st.
Needles: US 7, or size necessary to obtain given gauge.

Loosely cast on 39 sts. Work 6 rows of seed st ( $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) across, beginning every row with p 1 . For the rest of the washcloth, keep the first 5 sts and last 5 sts in seed st: (p1, k1, p1, k1, p1).
Row 1: 5 seed sts, k across to last 5 sts, work 5 seed sts.
Row 2: 5 seed sts, p across to last 5 sts, work 5 seed sts.
Row 3-6: Repeat rows 1 and 2 twice more.
Row 7: 5 seed sts, k9, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k9, 5 seed sts.
Row 8 and all even rows:
Repeat row 2.
Row 9: 5 seed sts, k8, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k8, 5 seed sts.
Row 11: 5 seed sts, k7, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k7, 5 seed sts.
Row 13: 5 seed sts, k6, k2tog, yo, k4, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k4, yo, ssk, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 15: 5 seed sts, k5, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k5, 5 seed sts.
Row 17: 5 seed sts, k6, yo, k2tog, k2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k2, ssk, yo, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 19: 5 seed sts, k6, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k1, ssk, yo, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 21: 5 seed sts, k6, yo, k2tog, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, ssk, yo, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 23: 5 seed sts, k6, yo, slip 2, k1, p2sso, yo, k2tog, yo, k7, yo, ssk, yo, slip 2, k1, p2sso, yo, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 25: 5 seed sts, k6, k2tog, yo, k2, yo k2tog, k5, ssk, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k6, 5 seed sts.
Row 27: 5 seed sts, k10, yo, k2tog, k5, ssk, yo, k10, 5 seed sts.
Row 29: Repeat row 27.
Row 31: 5 seed sts, k10, yo, k2tog, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, ssk, yo, k10, 5 seed sts.
Row 33: 5 seed sts, k10, yo, slip 2, k1, p2sso, yo, k3, yo, slip 2, k1, p2sso, yo, k10, 5 seed sts.
Row 35-40 Repeat rows 1-6.

Work 6 rows of seed st $(\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1)$ across row, beginning every row with p 1 . Bind off in seed st. Weave in ends. Dampen and block to flatten.
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ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathrm{K}=$ knit, st(s) = stitch(es), $\mathrm{RS}=$ right side, $\mathrm{WS}=$ wrong side, $\mathrm{YO}=$ yarn over, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, garter st = knit every row, ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, p2sso = pass the 2 slipped sts over the knitted st.
